Expectations:

Homework:

- Detailed homework sheet is provided in a Google Drive Folder or in Provided Notebook
- Students will be given individualized practice recommendations upon first lesson
- Theory Homework will be given weekly and checked at the beginning of each class
- Students are expected to have a proficient instrument for practice at home (keyboard/piano or guitar)

I am not a teacher to hound students for practicing. The desire to practice must come from the student themselves. I will give the recommendations and I hope you will follow it but you are unable to. I will not address this issue with disappointment or shame. If the issue persists and there is little to no improvement being seen, then we will work together to adapt and create a new plan. YOU GET OUT OF LESSONS WHAT YOU PUT IN. Regardless of this fact I do expect my students to work hard in my lessons and try all activities and exercises I present in class. PERSISTENT UNWILLINGNESS TO PARTICIPATE IN CLASS WILL RESULT IN REVALUATION OF WHETHER WE SHOULD CONTINUE LESSONS

Scheduling, Missed Classes and Lateness:

Weekly Lesson Time

At the beginning of each semester, we will select a weekly lesson time. This time is presumed to remain consistent for the duration of the semester:

Fall: September - December

❖ Winter/Spring: January - May

Summer: June – August

Lesson times may be adjusted if needed, as long as both the student and I agree on the change.

Flexibility & Rescheduling

While I strive to keep your weekly time consistent, I am currently in school and may occasionally need to shift lesson times. I will always give as much notice as possible.

You're also welcome to request a schedule change at any time, as long as it's done at least 4 hours in advance.

Payment

Lessons are billed on a rolling, per-lesson basis, unless otherwise arranged.

- Invoices will be emailed after each lesson
- ❖ Payments can be made via cash or e-transfer
- ❖ If a student is more than 2 payments behind, lessons will be paused until the balance is paid

Lesson Format

All lessons will be **in-person**.

Online lessons are available in special cases upon request but will not be the default. There is **no reduced rate** for online lessons.

Missed Classes & Cancellations

Because of the pay-as-you-go model, there is **no penalty** for missed lessons due to illness or vacation—**as long** as proper notice is given.

- Cancellations made within 4 hours of the scheduled time will be charged in full
- ❖ Cancellations made with more than 4 hours' notice will not be charged

Lateness Policy

If I am running behind, you are still entitled to your full lesson time.

We will either end late or, if you have a hard stop, the missed time can be:

- ❖ Added to a future lesson, or
- * Reflected in a reduced rate (to be agreed upon)

Conduct and Communication

I believe in leading with **kindness and respect** in all of my teaching. My goal is not only to help students improve their skills, but also to **foster a deep**, **lasting love for music**.

In lessons, I use positive, respectful language—and I expect the same from students in return, both during lessons and in all communication outside of lessons.
